PORTRAY HIS "LIVING" FRUIT

INTRODUCTION

God's children are in a spiritual warfare TODAY! Sin is all around us and our minds are slammed with so much despair, conflict, and confusion; it's no wonder we're struggling with living a fruitful life. We allow all of these bad things in the world to consume our mind and take control of our lives. When we focus too much on the bad things it can lead us to be counter-productive and become a hindrance in our spiritual walk. It prevents us from living and demonstrating a fruitful life for Jesus Christ.

If you're thinking about lust, sexual immorality, impure thoughts, envy, or ways opposite of what God teaches then you are allowing Satan to trap your mind with his sinful ways, which is contrary to God's ways.

If your attitude is uncaring, ungenerous, unloving, impatient, prideful, arrogant, vindictive, angry, hateful, or full of self-ambitious ways you can be characterized as a person of this world, not a person with a Christ-Like attitude, which means you are not living by the Spirit that Christ gave us.

The Fruit of the Spirit is one nine-fold "fruit" that characterizes all who truly walk in the Holy Spirit, which are: **love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control**. Collectively, these are the fruits that all Christians should be producing in their new and "real" lives in Jesus Christ.

The Fruit of the Spirit is a physical manifestation of a Christian's transformed life. **This should be your incentive for daily living!** You should study, understand, and apply the attributes of each element into your new life.

Are they visible, TODAY? Are you exemplifying each element? Are you expounding Christ-Like love, joy, peace and patience? How about Christ-Like kindness, gentleness or goodness to others? Are you exemplifying true faithfulness and self-controlling ways? Just how "real", compelling, and profound is your Christ-Like fruit? Is it portraying a clear message that you're a "real" child of God? Remember, you can not accomplish this feat on your own, but through the power of His Spirit you can reveal to the world a

glorious life of fruitfulness.

The Holy Spirit was sent to enable you to live this new and powerful life in Jesus Christ. By faith, you can have the power of His Spirit present. You must know the Holy Spirit to truly understand all that Jesus taught. When you completely submit to the power of His Spirit, you can experience Jesus' love as you allow Him to work in you.

Just as Jesus taught His disciples about the power of the Holy Spirit, you should allow Him to be present so you can exemplify His wonderful fruit(s). Once you come to Christ, completely, the Holy Spirit will indwell in you---He will convict you when you're out of line---He will guide you according to God's will---He will counsel you in living a fruitful life---AND He will give you a level of comfort and joy that is beyond belief.

Each element of the fruit is essential in living the "*real-life*". The only way you can truly understand and know how to apply them is through the daily study of God's word, prayer, and complete submission to Him. It is imperative that you believe and apply each element towards developing, living, and choosing His Way; **not your ways**.

1. "Do you live according to the **real** meaning of each element?"
2. "Which elements of the Fruit are your strongest; which ones are your weakest? Where can you improve?"

You must ascertain knowledge on the weaknesses in your life, for that is where the evil one will attack---he will assault your most vulnerable areas (Romans 7:23-25). Read the scriptures under each element and be submissive to His Spirit and He will guide you in making the right choices, TODAY!

When you take notes, be honest with yourself. God knows your heart and He knows all of your needs. Realize that each one of us have areas of improvement, for no one is perfect. God's Spirit is available for anyone who chooses Him. He will lead and guide you in living a life of truth in Him, but it requires your

complete trust and obedience to God.

Remember what God's word tells about His promise to give us the Holy Spirit.

John 14:15-17; *"If you love Me, obey My commandments. And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Counselor, who will never leave you. He is the Holy Spirit, who leads into all truth. The world at large cannot receive Him because it isn't looking for Him and doesn't recognize Him. But you do, because He lives with you now and later will be in you."*

Galatians 5:22-25; *"When the Holy Spirit controls our lives, He will produce this kind of fruit in us; **love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.**" Those who belong to Christ Jesus have nailed the passions and desires of their sinful nature to His cross and crucified them there. If we are living now by the Holy Spirit, let us follow the Holy Spirit's leading in every part of our lives."*

When you lay aside your sinful desires and draw on the power of the Holy Spirit you will produce a myriad of fruitfulness that is only available by living in Jesus Christ.

Your "real-life" TODAY should be of:

1. Christ-Like **Love** in the way you treat others! Exemplify His glorious ways.
2. Christ-Like **Joy** in all that you have in Him! Be happy in all things.
3. Christ-Like **Peace** in all situations! Think with a mind of Christ.
4. Christ-Like **Patience** in life! Don't force anything yourself.
5. Christ-Like **Kindness** to others! Care for others in need.
6. Christ-Like **Goodness**! Be a child of Godly moral and ethical beliefs.
7. Christ-Like **Faithfulness**! Trust in God in all areas of your life!
8. Christ-Like **Gentleness**! Through tough times be a Christ-Like model for others to see!
9. Christ-Like **Self-Control**! Let all that you say and do glorify his Name, **TODAY!**

When Christ is in your heart, you can demonstrate “*real*” Christ-likeness to others. God is interested in every part of your life because He wants you to develop pure and righteous thoughts; He wants you to live a role model like Jesus Christ; and He wants you to make Spiritual choices for the glory of His Kingdom. Never let the world determine and control your values and standards.

I Peter 1:13-16, “*So think clearly and exercise self-control. Look forward to the special blessings that will come to you at the return of Jesus Christ. Obey God because you are His children. Don’t slip back into your ways of doing evil; you didn’t know any better then. But now you must be holy in everything you do, **just as God who chose you to be His children is holy. You must be holy, because I am holy!**”*

God wants you to be holy, for He is holy. Living a holy life is godly---living a godly life is Christ-Like ---living a life of Christ-Likeness is exemplifying each element of the Fruit of the Spirit. When you’re living the “*real- life*” in Jesus Christ it will be your goal to make choices that honor God. Isn’t this the choice for each one of us TODAY? Always know that Jesus’ way is the only way!

John 14:6, “*I am the way, truth and life and no one comes to the Father except by Me.*”

Don’t use the excuse that you can’t help yourself from slipping back into sin. Rely on God’s power to FREE you from Satan’s grip. When you are guided and led by His Holy word and Spirit, He will empower you to live a blessed life in Him.

Psalms 119:165, “*Those who love your law have great peace and do not stumble.*”

2 Chronicles 16:9, “*The eyes of the Lord searches the whole earth in order to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to Him.*”

Ephesians 4:3, “*Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace.*”

Ephesians 4:30, “*And do not bring sorrow to God’s Holy Spirit by the way you live. Remember, He has identified you as His own, guaranteeing that you will be saved on the day of redemption.*”

Apply God's wonderful elements and the fruits of your labor will come to "real-life"! In a world of bad things you must stay united with the power of His Spirit and true to God's word. When you do your new life will be enriched and blessed by God. You are His, so honor Him by the way you think, live, and choose in life! Take a stand for what is right and pleasing to God and that is your choice of living in Christ!

Look at each one of the 9 elements in this study guide and learn them. Apply God's word to each study and allow His Spirit to teach you in the areas where you need to strive for His perfection and exemplify His glorious light.

Ephesians 5: 8-10, "For though your hearts were once full of darkness, now you are full of light from the Lord and your behavior should show it. For this light within you produces only what is good and right and true. Try to find out what is pleasing to the Lord, TODAY!"

Love – “*God has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with His love*” (Romans 5:5).

Love means putting others first. Love is an action—showing others you care; not just saying it. Christ-Like love is giving sacrificially to help the needs of others. It is a constellation of emotions related to a sense of strong affection or profound oneness! It’s an intimate personal relationship. It’s charitable, unconditional, and selfless. A true and “*real*” loving person cares for everyone; not a select few. Do you think God has a favorite group of people that He loves more than others? Aren’t we all equal in the eyes of God? Weren’t we all created by the Almighty One? Remember, God’s love is unconditional? What about your love for others?

Christ-Like love is not vengeful, jealous, boastful, full of pride or rude. Love is patient and kind and it is not irritable and never holds a grudge against anyone. Yes, anyone! Love never gives up and never loses faith. It is always hopeful and endures through every circumstance; it endures through suffering. A loving person is willing to live, give and share all that they have in Jesus Christ. There are three things that will endure; faith, hope, and love---and the greatest of these is Love! God is love and “*whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in him*” (1 John 4:16).

Keeping God’s law of love shows that your faith is “*real*”. When you exemplify love to others, you will overcome selfishness. It is all about others, not you.

Does this definition of love describe you? What is the true love of your life? How would you measure it? Is it number one? How would you rank it on a scale from 1-10 (ten being the highest)? How does that love compare to your love for Jesus Christ? If you really love Christ, are you obeying Him, TODAY?

To obey Christ fully, you must believe His command to love others. Helping and giving unto others who are in need puts Christ-Like love into action.

Love is very important to God. The greatest commandment is found in Matthew 22:37-39, “*Love the Lord your God with all of your heart, all your soul, and all your mind. This is the first and greatest*

commandment. A second is equally important: Love your neighbors as yourself.” How does this level of love measure up in your life TODAY?

Use these scriptures below as a guide to help you express Christ’s love in all areas of your life.

- + Love your **enemies & neighbors**: Matthew 5:44, Romans 13:9
- + Love **each other**: John 13:34-35 & John 15:12
- + Let His Love guide you; for it is the **greatest of ALL**: 1 Corinthians chapter 13
- + **Truly** Love One Another: I John 4:7-21
- + **Live** in Christian Love: Hebrews Chapter 13
- + Love is **patient, kind and not envious or rude**: I Corinthians 13:4-6

WHERE DO YOU NEED CHRIST-LIKE LOVE THE MOST, SO YOU CAN EXEMPLIFY HIS LOVING FRUIT? STAY ON TRACK WITH THE SCRIPTURE AND LIVE BY IT.

Joy – *"Don't be dejected and sad, for the joy of the Lord is your strength"* (Nehemiah 8:10).

Joy is emotion evoked by well-being or success. It is also characterized by gladness or delight. It is a way of expressing yourself in jubilation. Are you living a jubilant life? What brings you real delight and great pleasure? Is it a TV program, eating good food, visiting family or friends, the holidays, having a new car or home, money, appearance, clothes, or your position in life? What is “*real*” success to you? What is more important your earthly well-being or your spiritual life? What will last forever - the things of this earth or your soul?

Do you experience true joy when worshipping God? How about when you study His Holy Word, or witnessing to a lost soul? Do you have the ultimate joy in eternal life through Jesus Christ? Do you have joy in suffering for Christ? Do you have “*real*” joy in serving faithfully for Christ? Christ-Like joy is giving, living and sharing unselfishly of yourself: time, gifts, your abilities, money, and all that you’ve been blessed with? Read the book of Philippians and experience all the Joy you need in a grounded relationship with Jesus Christ.

Philippians 3:7-8 tells us, *“I once thought that all these things were so very important, but now I consider them worthless because of what Christ has done. Yes, everything else is worthless when compared with the priceless gain of knowing Jesus Christ my Lord. I have discarded everything else, counting it all as garbage, so that I may have Christ and become one with Him.”*

We can experience Christ-Like joy even in a world of evil. When you compare your list of worldly joys to Christ-Like joys, what is your “*real*” joy in life TODAY?

+ Have Joy as a **child of God**: Philippians 2:14-18

+ Have Joy in **eternal life** and: 1 Peter 1:6

Peace – *"So I pray that God, who gives you hope, will keep you happy and full of peace as you believe in Him. May you overflow through the power of the Holy Spirit"* (Romans 15:13).

"Therefore, since we have been made right in God's sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what our Lord Jesus Christ has done for us" (Romans 5:1).

Are you experiencing a life of peace, TODAY? If you're "really" trusting God you will attain inner peace. Continue to obey His word and dedicate your life to God and He will fill you with a level of peace that will help you to overcome any negative area(s). Don't let inner feelings of hostility, anger, jealousy, envy, pride, greed or anything of impurity keep you from striving for God's state of peace and harmony.

Don't exert all of your energy in areas that are not pertinent to your Christ-Like level of peace, for they will bring you to a level of complacency and stagnation; this is not healthy for the spirit. Represent Christ-Like peace with an exemplariness of goodwill, respect, free of strife, and humility.

How calm are you during a time of distress? Are you really at peace with everything in life; your job, your boss, government, where you live, your children, family, your church home, your finances, your neighbors, your friends or **yourself**? Are you at peace with the way you live? Be true to yourself with this question: "Does the world see "real" inner-peace through your Christ-Like actions, TODAY?"

It is amazing to see the various groups of activists throughout the world attempting to petition and establish "their" respective cause of peace. There is nothing wrong with standing up for things that are morally and ethically right. However, if people applied these earthly efforts of peace into their own spiritual life how much "real" and fruitful peace would there be in the world, TODAY?

Do you really want the best for others? **Remember, we are all one in Christ so there should be no barriers, no divisions, no discrimination, no friction or animosity.** As His own, we all belong to Him so we should live in peace and harmony with one another. This is God's way!

Apply these scriptures of peace to your life.

- + **Live** in Peace: Colossians 3:15
- + Live in Peace with **everyone**: Romans 12:18
- + Make **every effort** to live in Peace: Hebrews 12:14
- + **Pursue** Peace: 2 Timothy 2:22

LIVING A LIFE OF PEACEFULNESS IS PRICELESS----ONLY CHRIST CAN HELP YOU!

Patience – “We also pray that you will be strengthened with His glorious power so that you will have all the patience and endurance you need. May you be filled with joy, always thanking the Father, who has enabled you to share the inheritance that belongs to God’s holy people, who live in the light” (Colossians 1:11-12).

Patience is one of the most valuable virtues in life. It is someone who exemplifies calmness, uncomplaining, enduring and persevering attributes. How many of us fail in these areas? In the heat of the moment on the job, in your home, or simply anywhere, how well do you keep your composure in a Christ-Like way? Did you complain about anything TODAY?

During longsuffering do you endure and persevere with Christ-Like patience? At times, do you get so impatient with others you take things in your own hands and make selfish decisions? How would others rate your level of patience? Are you patient with your spouse, children, peers or subordinates on the job, your boss or employer, brothers and sisters in Christ, friends, neighbors, strangers on the street, or simply with anyone?

TODAY, you may come across that one person whose life you could impact---forever! Did you act with Christ-Like patience? Did they see a calming and virtuous person who exemplified a radiance of Christ-Like ways?

No wonder this Fruit is one of the most valuable virtues in life. If you live in calmness and uncomplaining ways, and endure and persevere through all of life’s storms, you are living in God’s true wisdom and knowledge. You are allowing the power of the Holy Spirit to be seen in all that you say and do for the glory of Christ.

Do these scriptures point you to a life of patience?

+ **Wait** Patiently for the Lord: Psalm 27:14

+ Be Patient with **everyone**: 1 Thessalonians 5:14

Kindness – “We have proved ourselves by our purity, understanding, patience, kindness, sincere love, and the power of the Holy Spirit” (2 Corinthians 6:6-7).

Are you someone who is charitable---doing for the good of others---those who are poor or distressed? Are you compassionate, sympathetic, generous, good-nature, merciful, forgiving, agreeable, over-lenient, and someone just pleasant to be with? When’s the last time you helped someone in need? When’s the last time someone told you that you were “*really*” generous or sympathetic? When is the last time you forgave someone for something they did, no matter whose fault it was? How agreeable are you in a meeting? How about with your family and friends, neighbors, or your brothers and sisters in Christ? Has anyone ever told you that you’re pleasant to be with? How do you “*really*” feel about your acts of Kindness? Are you merciful and forgiving to those who may have did something wrong to you? If none of these apply to your life, then you need to seek Christ-Like Kindness, TODAY. If you don’t yield to people’s emotions what is preventing you from reacting in a kind way. What is the root of the problem? How do the scriptures apply to you, TODAY?

- + Your soul is **nourished** when you are Kind. Proverbs 11:17
- + Kind words are like honey-sweet to the soul and **healthy for the body**. Proverbs 16:24
- + **Blessed** are those who are generous, because they **feed the poor**. Proverbs 22:9
- + **Clothe** yourself with Kindness: Colossians 3:12
- + Be Kind, for it **exemplifies Love**: 1 Corinthians 13:4

Goodness – "And so we keep on praying for you, that our God will make you worthy of the life to which He called you. And we pray that God, by His power, will fulfill all your good intentions and faithful deeds" (2 Thessalonians 1:11).

"For the Fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth" (Ephesians 5:9).

Would you classify yourself as someone who is morally and ethically upright, good-hearted, friendly, likable, cordial, and of upstanding integrity? Are you living a life of Christ-Like Goodness? Or are you on the other side of the spectrum living a life of evilness, corruptness, immorality, wickedness and sinfulness? Are you living in the ways of the Spirit **OR** the flesh? You can not do both and be a "real" child of God! What are your moral values in life? Are you ethically true in Christ-Like ways? How friendly are you on your job, at home, in the community, on the streets, or in God's house? Has anyone told you that you're a "real" person of integrity? Are you liked by all? Not just a select few, but by everyone? What about in the grocery store, on the highway (touchy area for many), in an airport, or simply anywhere? Are you disliked by anyone? If so, out of the goodness of your "real" heart have you made an effort to make things right? Are you walking down the path of Christ-Like Goodness---His righteousness?

As Christians, we must commit and discipline ourselves to serve one another. Are you putting your "real" life of goodness in action TODAY---serving others?

Do these scriptures apply to your "real" good life?

Live in the Spirit, not in the flesh! You cannot live both!

- + Good people are **guided by their honesty**. Proverbs 11:3

- + **Live** a life of Goodness and righteousness: Romans 14:17

- + Be a **Christ-Like example** by doing Good: Titus 2:7-8

- + Do Good to those **who hate you**: Luke 6:27

Faithfulness – *"I pray that out of his glorious unlimited resources He will give you might & inner strength through His Holy Spirit. And I pray that Christ will be more and more at home in your hearts as you trust in Him. May you're your roots grow down deep into the soil of God's marvelous love "* (Ephesians 3:16-17).

Faithfulness is to adopt or support a cause with no uncertainties; it is complete & unquestionable. You are loyal and true to this cause and you completely rely on-religiously. You adhere to and believe in it-100%.

Where does your trust or loyalty lie TODAY? What do you adhere to in life? Do you rely on God for all things---in every area of your life? Is your loyalty to Him, **first and foremost**? Your life is not complete until you come to faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. Remember, it is your faith in Christ that provides your salvation, but it is God's grace that saves you.

However, thank God for His mercy and love when He saved you He gives you faith! Through this faith, He carries you from death into life---this is the completeness of your "*real-life*" in Christ. Is your life completely entrusted in Him, TODAY? Is your belief in the One who paid the price for your sins and mine, **100%**?

If you trust in Jesus Christ for your complete salvation, He will transform you completely, TODAY! A "*real-life*" of trust and obedience is pleasing to God. Living with "*real*" faith makes a difference, for it separates your reliance from the worldly beliefs. It is not just your words, but it's also seen by your choices. Is your "*real*" faith at work, TODAY? Does the world see who you "*really*" rely on for everything?

Serving Jesus Christ faithfully will bring about opposition and suffering, but this shows that your "*real*" faithfulness is impacting others. As you continue to trust Jesus Christ in your daily life, He will give you the strength needed to be steadfast in Him.

How do these scriptures apply to your life of faithfulness?

+ **Understand** God's Faithfulness, Be Faithful to the end: Hebrews chapter 11 & 13:4

Gentleness – “*But the wisdom that comes from Heaven is first of all pure. It is also peace loving, gentle at all times, and willing to yield to others. It is full of mercy and good deeds. It shows no partiality and is always sincere*” (James 3:17).

Gentleness exemplifies mild-mannered and kind ways. Gentleness can be viewed as a refinement of character in difficult times. A thoughtful, willing, loving, and gentle approach can serve as a **model for others**. Who is someone you’ve looked up to as a model for others; someone who was considerate of others during tough times, and not just themselves?

Didn’t God think of you when He sent His only Son upon the cross to die for all of your sins, which provided you eternal life when you come to Christ by faith? Isn’t Jesus Christ the true model for each one of us TODAY? What is the exemplary of your ways during stormy trials? Are you a person of quietness during times of turmoil? Do you live with an inner peace that truly exemplifies Christ-Like mild mannered and kind ways? Do people want to be around you or come to you for advice during their stormy times in life? Do they see a “*real*” Godly person of true gentleness? How do the scriptures below apply to your life? Do you exhibit true gentleness? Do you exemplify Christ-Like humbleness and willingness in your life, no matter what the situation may be?

- + A Gentle answer **turns away wrath**. Proverbs 15:1
- + Gentle words **bring life and health**. Proverbs 15:3
- + Let My Gentleness **be evident to all**: Philippians 4:5
- + **Be Humble** and Gentle: Ephesians 4:2

In the journal below what type of role model are you exemplifying, TODAY?

Self-Control – *"So make every effort to apply the benefits of these promises to your life. Then your faith will produce a life of moral excellence. A life of moral excellence leads to knowing God better. Knowing God leads to self-control. Self-control leads to endurance, and patient endurance leads to godliness. Godliness leads to love for other Christians and finally you will grow to have genuine love for everyone. The more you grow like this the more you will become productive and useful in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ"* (2 Peter 1:5-7).

Are you making a “*real*” effort in self-controlling your weakest areas? With all of the temptations in the world this is a major obstacle for millions. Satan is going to be relentless in his attacks against your weakest areas---do you now know them? Through the power of God’s word and His Spirit, He has enabled you to examine your ways and make the choices that will impact your life for His glory, BUT you have to be willing, disciplined, trusting, obedient, and committed, **100%!**

No matter what circumstances that come your way, TODAY, how will you handle it? Will it be in a: loving, joyous, peaceful, patient, kind, good, faithful and gentle approach? Or will it be with hostility, anger, envy, jealousy, quarrelsome, self-ambition, greed, pride, lying, stealing, conceit or impure thoughtfulness?

If you chose the latter group you are living in the ways of your sinful desires, not God’s ways. If you “truly” focused on the first eight elements of His Fruit, applied God’s word to your life and submitted to the power of His Spirit, you will find self-control to be much easier in life. His power can help you to attain victory in life TODAY!

Do you have sinful desires that you can’t seem to control? Have you faithfully brought them to the Lord? If you take each weakness, one at a time, understand them, apply God’s word to your life, and allow the Holy Spirit to lead you, He will bless you with a level of strength, wisdom, and knowledge that will help you to overcome these negative vices. Once again, DO NOT give the evil one the gratification of defeating you in life. Grow in your fruitful life and allow God to produce Christ-Like self-control. **Be someone who is**

Allow God to control every area so He can produce a life of fruitfulness! Nothing else in life matters, BUT your “*real-life*” in Him!

Philippians 3:8-9, “*Yes, everything else is worthless when compared with the priceless gain of knowing Jesus Christ my Lord. I have discarded everything else, counting it all as garbage, so that I may have Christ and become one with Him. I no longer count on my goodness or my ability to obey God’s law, but I trust Christ to save me. For God’s way of making us right with Himself depends on faith.*”

As you observe each one of these elements have you “*really*” placed your value in knowing, growing, and showing Christ-Likeness in all areas? If your ultimate choice is in Jesus Christ, your priorities in life are formed around His ways, **not your ways**.

Once you completely, wholly, truly, and “*really*” submit to God, you will attain a level of wisdom and knowledge that will help you in today’s life. You will start to experience Godly thoughts of peace and joy, you will portray a Christ-Like attitude of love, patience, goodness, kindness, gentleness AND your Spiritual choices will reveal His faithfulness and self-controlling ways.

If people ask you today, “what is the measuring stick of living a Christ-Like life, what do I need to do or strive for each day to show that His ways are portrayed in my life?” These 9 elements are your level of performance---TODAY.

God’s word mentions many specific measurements and attitudes that are right or wrong. The Fruit of the Spirit are the desires and qualities that a Christian should live by each day. When you fail in one or more take it to the Lord **and He will help you**.
